1. The way of life, traditions and beliefs of a particular group of people at a particular time; includes their art, religion, and system of government.
2. Art created for the pharaohs' palaces, tombs and temples.
3. The system of spiritual beliefs that explains why events happen in the world.
4. Artwork created in Europe from 400 – 1400 AD; many of it was created to decorate Catholic churches.
5. People organize themselves into a community and create this organization to provide the services – roads, courts, and laws - that they need for protection and mutual help.
6. The artwork created in the empire of semi-independent city-states in the eastern Mediterranean from the 8th – 3rd centuries BC.
7. Artists are influenced by those who came before them and influence those who come after them.
8. A group of artists who painted landscapes, common people and entertainers using bright colors and loose brushstrokes.
9. People who hire artists to create artworks for them, such as churches, murals, paintings and buildings.
10. During this period, there are many styles of art, such as Cubism, Surrealism, Abstract Expressionism and no one style predominates.
