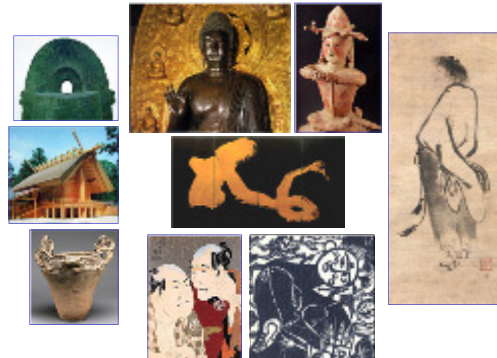

## Guide to Pronunciation

- The Preface in the textbook has the standard way to pronounce the vowels page 8.
- Most words have no accent, or a very slight one.
- How syllables work:
  - Mahayana = Ma - ha - ya - na
  - Yakushi = Ya - ku - shi (she)
  - Heijokyo = Hei (hay) - jo - ky (key) - o
  - Todaiji = To - dai (dye) - ji (gee)
  - Fukukenjaku = Fu - ku - ken - ja - ku
